An integral component of Frontec's mission in the North is to provide exemplary technical and management services to our Canadian and U.S. Government customers, while increasing opportunities for Indigenous participation as trainees, employees, suppliers and partners.

Spanning Canada's North and Alaska, Frontec's presence in the North American Arctic provides a foundation to support its resource partner's projects as well as Arctic sovereignty and infrastructure initiatives undertaken by the Canadian Forces and other federal organizations in the region.

Frontec has a history of successfully supporting our clients, whatever the location, size or complexity of the operation.

Providing facility inspection, maintenance and repair, new construction and upgrades, trade services and environmental services to Canadian Armed Forces sites in Yellowknife, Whitehorse, Inuvik, Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet.

For the past 20 years, the business has provided facility maintenance and airfield services at 160 microwave sites across Northern British Columbia, the Northwest Territories, Nunavut and the Yukon through a partnership between Frontec and the Northern Aboriginal Services Company (NASCo). The contract includes the inspection and maintenance of all power generating systems.

UQSUQ

The UQSUQ Corporation is a Frontec partnership with the Nunavut Petroleum Corporation. It operates and maintains the Iqaluit bulk fuel storage facility and pipeline distribution system and the delivery of petroleum products, including gasoline, diesel, home heating fuel, AV-gasoline and jet fuel.

CURRENT NORTHERN PORTFOLIO



Resolute Bay Operations

Frontec has been operating a diverse portfolio of projects in Resolute Bay since 1970. This includes the operation of two hotels, maintaining transport and construction equipment, fuel storage, water treatment and radar sites.

Alaska Radar System

ARCTEC Alaska, a partnership between Frontec and ASRC Federal Primus, provides operations and maintenance services to 15 strategic radar sites that form the Alaska Radar System (ARS) under the authority of the United States Department of the Air Force.

Torngait Services

In partnership with the Nunatsiavut Group of Companies (an Inuit-owned business), Frontec provides logistics and support services to hydroelectric, mining and exploration companies in Labrador. This includes water treatment, road maintenance, fuel and hazardous materials management, operating the port, site support and core drilling services. Major customers include Vale and Valard Construction.

PAST PERFORMANCE



Iqaluit Airport

Frontec provided operations and maintenance services for the Iqaluit airport from 1999 to 2004. This included services such as 24-hour security, roads and grounds maintenance, facility maintenance, mechanical services, wildlife control, janitorial, boiler and generator maintenance.



North Warning System

From 1987 - 2014, Nasittuq (a partnership between Frontec and the Pan Arctic Inuit Logistics Corporation) operated and maintained the North Warning System a network of radars protecting North America's security and sovereignty. Nasittuq still provides site support and management services for the Ellesmere Island commercial support contract in Alert, Nunavut.

Since 1981, ATCO has been creating successful Indigenous partnerships throughout Northern Canada and Alaska. Whenever we begin a project, we engage communities to learn about their unique needs and provide opportunities that meet those needs.
