From Home Safety to Future Responders: ATCO Supports Fire Safety in Wood Buffalo

CALGARY, Alberta – ATCO Ltd. (TSX: ACO.X)

As the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo (RMWB) marks the 10-year anniversary of the 2016 wildfires, ATCO is reinforcing its long-standing commitment to protecting the community by supporting two important fire prevention and youth engagement initiatives delivered in partnership with the RMWB Fire Department: [The Home Fire Safety Program](#) and Camp Xtreme.

ATCO has committed \$25,000 over five years to support the fire safety program's goals of providing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors for households in need, and supporting fire safety education to help residents better guard their homes and families.

In addition, ATCO will provide \$5,000 in 2026 Camp Xtreme, a series of three four-day summer camps that introduce youth to the fire service through hands-on learning, teamwork and leadership development. The program aims to build awareness of emergency response careers while strengthening skills that support community resilience.

ATCO has a long history of supporting fire safety and youth education initiatives across Alberta, including Fire Cadet programs, smoke alarm blitzes and community education efforts in collaboration with local fire departments.
