



ATCO achieved an in-situ style finish through modular manufacture, developing a 10-acre parcel of land for its Sydney office and hire facility.

The office, with the look and finish of a permanent, insitu style commercial office, retained all the benefits of modular construction including the compression of the overall project timeframe. This allowed building manufacture to occur in conjunction with site works, providing a 460% project time saving.

Careful selection of fixtures and finishing, and installation components, including concealed roof beams, achieved a modern architectural aesthetic.

PROJECT FEATURES

- High specification external cladding to elevate the office building façade.
- Recessed lighting, flush finish ceiling, seamless module and skirting joins and installation of glass partition walls.
- The benefits of modular construction provided an approximate time and cost saving equaling \$800,000.
