

HOMES FOR HEROES



In November 2019, we leveraged our expertise in modular housing to build ATCO Village, a community of 15 tiny homes in Calgary for veterans of the Canadian Armed Forces.

Building upon our long and proud history of supporting the Canadian military, we partnered with the Homes for Heroes Foundation, the McCann Family Foundation and the Canadian Legacy Project to provide housing and a robust support system for veterans who are experiencing homelessness. The community formed by these homes features a resource centre, community gardens and memorials to Canadian soldiers who lost their lives in Afghanistan.

ATCO provided our expertise in the design, build, manufacture, delivery and placement of units on ATCO-supplied pile foundations. These tiny homes showcase ATCO's urban design capabilities and provide a home our military heroes will be proud to call their own – a small gesture when measured against their herculean sacrifice. In total, we have committed a \$1.5 million gift-in-kind donation to support the Homes for Heroes Foundation.

With ATCO Village in Calgary now complete, we are proud to work with the Homes For Heroes Foundation to build another village in Edmonton. This village will feature 18 tiny homes, two accessible homes, one office and an amenity building, and is scheduled to open in 2021.

Each of these 275 sq. ft. full-amenity dwellings took 250 hours to build, and feature ample natural light and an open, friendly feel.

The homes are engineered for enhanced energy efficiency, environmental performance, and to minimize operational costs for residents.
